

Dear Supporters,

Of course, the big accomplishment of this year was the one many of you have been waiting for, and that is the publication of the calendar's companion book, "Counting The Days"! Since the calendar was first produced for 2009, it has always been the intent to have a companion book to go with it which would do the deeper teaching this ministry is suppose to be providing. I know this book has not answered all the questions different ones have about the feasts and other elements on the calendar, but it is a great foundation for doing that further teaching. Thus, I would have to say our real goal for 2018 is to join together in prayer that God will lead us through this next year and open those doors of opportunity He wants us to take so we do not waste any precious time we may have left.
